

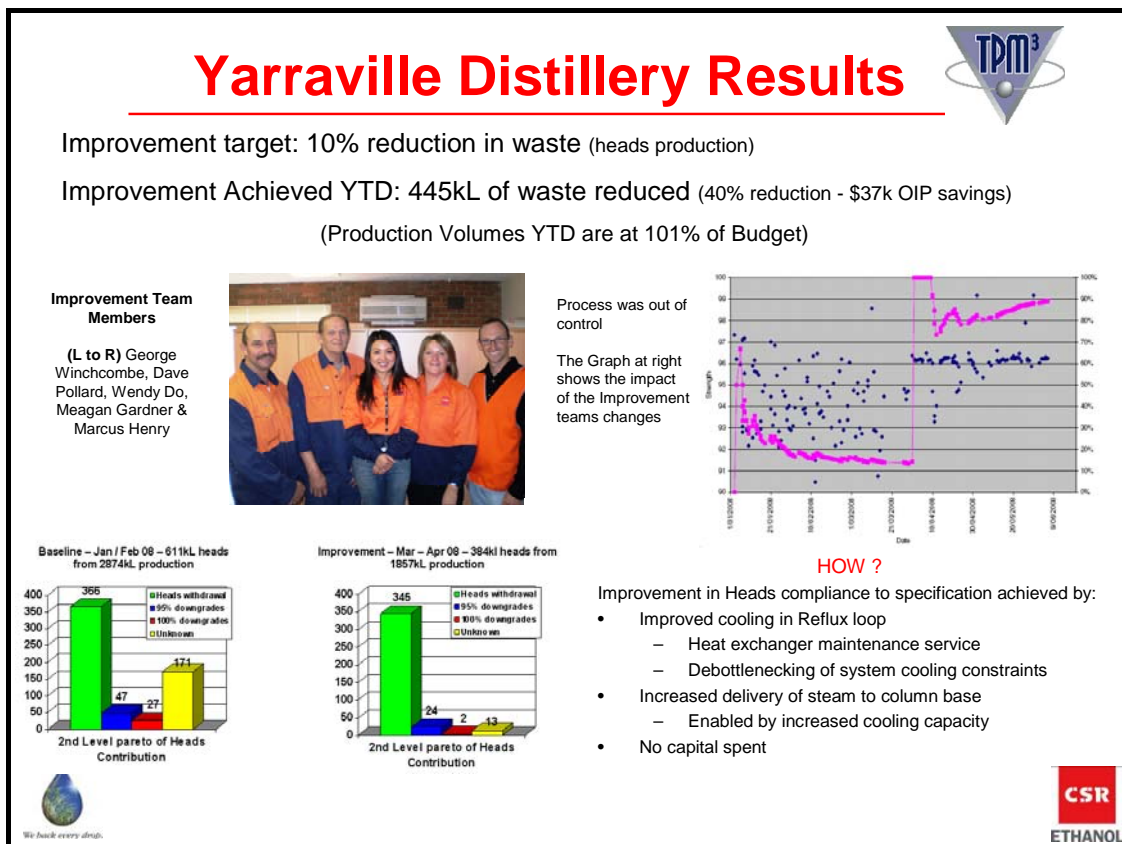
Reporting has a new size.....A3
